

Feeding Policy

The Dog Nook at Cranbrook believes mealtimes should feel familiar and stress-free - just like they do at home. We follow each dog's usual feeding routine as closely as possible, making sure they're comfortable, calm, and well cared for around food.

What we feed

- We ask all owners to bring their dog's regular food with clear instructions, including portion size, feeding times, and any extras (like warm water, supplements, or mixers).
- We're happy to accommodate a range of diets including raw, kibble, home-cooked, or combination feeding - as long as all food is provided by you.
- If your dog runs out of food while staying with us, we'll contact you to arrange a top-up, or discuss a suitable temporary alternative.

When & how

- Dogs are fed individually and in a quiet space to avoid stress, competition, or food guarding.
- We feed at the times your dog is used to whether that's once, twice, or three times a day.
- Slow feeders, lick mats, or enrichment-style feeding are

happily used if they're part of your dog's normal routine.

Fresh water is always available, indoors and out.

Cleanliness & safety

- Food and water bowls are washed thoroughly after each use.
- Raw food preparation is handled with care and in line with hygiene best practice.
- We monitor all dogs during mealtimes and report any changes in appetite or behaviour around food.

Trust & enrichment

- We offer the occasional treat with your permission always safe, natural, and suitable.
- You're welcome to bring your dog's favourite treats, chews, or food puzzles to help them settle in and feel at home.
